Plot 39 has not yet received the agreed letter. It is on the Clerk's to do list Plot 54, Community Allotment raised some concerns:

- How can it be assured that only plot holders attend the Glebe allotments?
- Are the Giving Community members insures? Only Anna O'Neill is covered by the Allotment Association insurance.
- How can we ensure that giving Community members remain on their own plot? Some have been seen looking around other plots.

Simons Cross is all OK and fully let. Last year's rat problem will be kept under review.

- Market Report: Published. Councillor Westover presented her report covering markets, cemetery and tree work. There was some discussion regarding rabbit control at the cemetery with suggestions ranging from a stock fence to use of ferrets. As there was no proposal, no decisions could be lawfully made. A proposal reviewing methods and recommending a strategy should be put on the face of the agenda for the next meeting.
- **13 Proposal to appoint a working group** to produce a schedule of works for the grounds maintenance contract
